SNYDERMAN-WORKS GALLERIES

PLUS AN EXHIBIT OF WORK FROM THE PAPPAS COLLECTION BY CERAMIC  
SCULPTOR **WILLIAM WYMAN**

**Philadelphia, PA.** For more than 60 years, **Marilyn Pappas** has successfully pursued an artistic career that is in itself a chronology of art through the latter half of the 20th and the early decades of the 21st Centuries.

Born in 1931, she was one of a selected group of nationally recognized artist/ designers chosen to be part of the landmark 1969 exhibition, **Objects: USA**, organized by legendary Curator Lee Nordness, which toured leading museums in the United States, and included Anni Albers, Jack Lenor Larsen, Dorothy Liebes, Robert Arneson, Wendell Castle, Sheila Hicks, and **William Wyman** among others. During the 1970's Pappas and Wyman lived and maintained studios together until his untimely death in 1980.

We have had the honor of representing her work for more than 15 years, presenting it at exhibits in New York, Chicago and Philadelphia.

This solo exhibit of works from 1999 through 2013 is all the more remarkable because eight of the nineteen pieces were completed during the last two years and will receive their first showing in this exhibition. They represent her return to the extensive use of color, including a new series of eight 'map journey' collages stitched on framed antiquarian maps of Europe.

To further commemorate this special event, Pappas has organized an exhibition of **William Wyman's** ceramic sculptures. Drawn from her personal collection, they will be shown at the gallery in conjunction with her exhibition – a rare and unique opportunity to see the work of these two historically significant American artists.
