For the tightrope walker, the only thing that separates falling to one side or the other is a thin line. The tension of almost falling, slipping from action to reaction causes the crowd to gasp. That moment of stasis is a threshold I seek to create. As an artist, I am trying to reveal the drama between binary relationships. My art practice, at its very core, is rumination between mundane truths and extraordinary phenomena. The making of objects is a necessary part of understanding this dual mindset.
